

ABSTRACT FORMAT

The abstract must be submitted by the person attending the event and presenting the paper. It can be submitted by any of the paper's authors (not necessarily the first author).

- 1. TITLE: It must be sufficiently explanatory of the paper to be presented. Format: Times New Roman 24 bold font with centered text.
- 2. AUTHORS: It must include the names of the main author(s) and co-author(s), their institution, the city and country, and the email address of the person presenting the talk or poster. Format: Full names (First Name, Last Name) below the title with superscript indicating the institution and contact information (per author). Font: Times New Roman 12; centered text. The information listed in each superscript (institution, city, country, and email address) should be in order below the author's name. Font: Times New Roman 10-point type; justified text.
- 3. ABSTRACT: The abstract should include a brief introduction to the research's motivations, objectives, methodology, and main results and conclusions. Format: Justified text; Times New Roman 12-point type, single-spaced; a maximum of 250 words. Avoid the use of abbreviations. The abstract should NOT include references.
- 4. KEYWORDS: Indicate five keywords that quickly identify the topic of the work. Format: Justified text; Times New Roman 12-point type, italics, single-spaced.
- 5. ACKNOWLEDGMENTS: The funding source or institutional support must be included.

Format: Justified text; Times New Roman font, size 12, single-spaced.
